The EU provides a range of funding programs for researchers, including grants for individual researchers, collaborative projects, and research infrastructures.

The Horizon Europe program is the EU's flagship funding program for research and innovation, which includes funding for Neurosciences research.

The **ERC grants** are highly competitive and support individual researchers conducting **cutting-edge research** in their respective fields.

The MSCA program offers funding for researchers at all career stages, including PhD students, postdoctoral fellows, and experienced researchers, to carry out research in different EU countries.

To support its researchers in applying for funding, the UBNeuro collaborates since 2020 with the grant consultancy company Hezelburcht. Dr. Naomi de Haas is the primary contact point and has supported more than 15 researchers from UBNeuro during their grant preparation.
